## Who We Are

Amy Pinder, a speech-language therapist, and Leah Barron, a special educator, co-founded *All Inclusive Productions*, a benefit corporation dedicated to making the world more accessible and inclusive through education and experiences.

In 2018, we launched *Inclusion Festival*, the nation's first and only sensory-friendly music and wellness festival designed to include and accommodate individuals with and without autism and other special needs. *Inclusion Festival* provides unique, immersive experiences that are often inaccessible to individuals impacted by special needs, while providing the general community with an allencompassing educational and uplifting experience that demonstrates the value of all people.



Its success inspired us to do more to increase its impact through various other community initiatives. Accordingly, we launched *Inclusion Magazine*, a free online publication celebrating all abilities, sensory-supportive *Inclusion Zones*, *Inclusion Dining* experiences, and *Inclusion Training* programs in the tri-state area.

Each inclusive event we create celebrates the value of all people and all abilities through music, the arts, nature, movement, and more with a goal of strengthening self-awareness, encouraging exploration of passions and interests, building community and personal relationships, and helping people connect with their inner purpose to guide and sustain positive lifestyle choices.

# Why Create an Inclusion Zone?

Today, 650 million people live with a disability, which equates to nearly 1 in 5 individuals worldwide. Of those, only 20% have a disability that is visible. The majority of people living with invisible disabilities are individuals with autism. Those with autism, anxiety, ADHD, and other sensory-processing disorders often experience sensory overload, limiting their ability to comfortably and successfully participate in community experiences.

Sensory supportive *Inclusion Zones* respond to this issue by offering an accessible and inclusive location that is available to *all* individuals who may benefit from the opportunity to take a quiet break from the general environment in order to maintain or regain emotional regulation and learn about supportive, take-away strategies.

# **Inclusion Zone Overview**

*Inclusion Zones* are created and managed by therapists and educators with expertise in autism and sensory-processing issues. This dedicated space provides services, tools, and amenities known to benefit individuals with sensory-processing issues of all ages and abilities.

#### Features include:

- Soothing, ambient sounds
- Relaxing colors and visual art
- Comfortable seating such as bean bags and anti-gravity chairs
- Noise-cancelling headphones and earplugs
- Aromatherapy
- Tactile opportunities
- Weighted blankets
- Relaxation activities
- Temperature regulation
- Mindfulness practices such as restorative yoga, self-massage, breathing exercises, visualization techniques, etc. offered on an ongoing, as-needed basis by trained staff
- Tips and strategies for managing the general environment
